#### MESSAGE FROM THE VICAR OF THE CATHEDRAL

My dear Friends in Christ,

Greetings to you in the name of Jesus Christ our Saviour!

**Church:** As we make our Lenten pilgrimage, I trust that our time of inward reflection will help us make sense of our calling.

This month we also keep Mothering Sunday which is also referred to as Parenting Sunday. Our guest preacher will be Rev. John Attenborough, the Regional Head of the Mission to Seafarers for Middle East and South Asia (MESA).

Nation: The people of our nation continue to have to live through very difficult times. It looks likely that the provincial council elections that were initially scheduled for this month will not take place now. Amidst the uncertainty and the soaring cost of living, the difficulties that people appear to have to contend with are causing a rather large segment of the population to exit the country. This is causing a serious "brain drain" and the number of professionals leaving the country is extremely alarming. While the people are being called to exercise financial caution and restraint, those in leadership in the country appear to be living far from this reality. Our country suffers today due to a lack of statesmen with vision, courage and integrity. I continue to urge you to pray that God will raise such leaders from the people to replace the politicians we seem to be forced to put up with.
