

MESSAGE FROM THE VICAR OF THE CATHEDRAL

My dear Friends in Christ,

Greetings to you in the name of Jesus Christ our Saviour!

Church: As we progress through Ordinary Time in our Liturgical calendar, our focus of attention would now move to the Mission and Ministry of the Church.

Nation: With so much uncertainty prevailing over observing the actual implications of the Domestic Debt Restructuring that is taking place, once again the issue that surfaces in the minds of the citizens is accountability.

The current turmoil is the result of poor management by those in office for successive years and it is almost like poetic justice that the very people who have elected these leaders that have failed the nation are now called to carry the brunt of their mismanagement.

It will be even more interesting to know if there has been some element of political maturity and realization among the citizens of the country who struggle at this time.

50th **Anniversary of the Cathedral:** On the 24th of June 2023 we had 12 professional choirs and our Cathedral choir take part in 'Hallelujah! A festival of choirs'. It was indeed a very inspiring and uplifting evening of music with over 325 voices singing in a gathering of over 2100 people.

Confirmation Service: The confirmation service will take place on Sunday 23rd July 2023 at 8.30 am. Your prayers will be appreciated for the candidates being prepared to be presented to the Bishop for confirmation.

Cathedral Pola: After the lapse of a few years preparations are being made for the Cathedral Pola on Sunday 17th September 2023. Tara Ramanayake is working with a team of persons who are planning out this year's Pola. This planning and the Pola itself is an opportunity for the entire Community to come together to build and strengthen their bonds of fellowship and work to raise the required funds for the work of the Cathedral Worshipping Community. Your fullest support to the team of volunteers engaged in this task would be appreciated gratefully.

Community Kitchen (CK): I also wish to convey my gratitude to all our donours who so selflessly, sacrificially and generously support this community initiative financially.


Pastoral Care: Even though the Pastoral care team may be stretched at this time, please do not hesitate to contact me in case of a Pastoral emergency.



Be an **Activity Leader** by taking over one of the many interesting tasks and campaigns that we would be engaging our participants in during this journey.


VOLUNTEER
