MESSAGE FROM THE VICAR OF THE CATHEDRAL

My dear Friends in Christ,

Greetings to you in the name of Jesus Christ our Saviour!

Church: As we commence another season of Advent, I would like to take this opportunity to remind ourselves that Advent is traditionally not about Christ's first coming as a baby but about His second coming in judgment, vindication and mercy. This season has also inevitably come to be seen as a period of preparation for the celebration of the Feast of the Nativity. Therefore, it's a space that we could also make use of creatively for the benefit of the worshipping community.

Nation: In the last few weeks, we seem to be hearing of some scandal or corruption on a daily if not weekly basis. What is fundamentally disappointing to note is that no one appears to be responsible for what has taken place. But with the passage of time, those responsible for this will be revealed, as history often shows.

This was evident in the recent landmark judgment by the Supreme Court as it names those responsible for the collapse of the nation's economy.

New Archdeacons: Ven. Christopher Balaraj and Rev. Charles David have been named the 24th Archdeacon of Colombo and 8th Archdeacon of Nuwara Eliya respectively. The date for the service of installation and institution is still to be decided at the time of this publication.

New Vicar of the Cathedral: Rev. Lakshman Daniel will assume duties as your shepherd and Vicar on the 1st of January 2024. I wish to extend a warm welcome to him and his wife Anne as he commences his work with you.

As the children are really working hard to make a presentation with a difference, I would like to encourage members of the worshipping community to take a little time after the service and walk around to see their craft work that will also be on display.

Remembrance Sunday Service: We were also able to observe Remembrance Sunday this year amidst a very good gathering.

50th Anniversary of the Cathedral – A Moment in Time: Our 50th Anniversary Celebrations came to a close with a very well attended service of thanksgiving held on 18th November 2023. It was such a joy to be in the presence of such a cross section of people to whom the Cathedral has been their diocesan cathedral. With the Church of Ceylon moving towards becoming a Province, this Cathedral will not be the diocesan cathedral soon to some as new diocesan cathedrals are created and existing diocesan boundaries are redefined. Hence, this, one could say, was a historic gathering for many reasons.

I wish to place on record my appreciation to the Anniversary Committee for their commitment and dedication as we have worked together through the last 15 months planning 10 events, programmes and activities leading up to the final celebration of God's faithful provision in and through 50 years of ministry and mission.

Community Kitchen (CK): Our Community Kitchen now feeds 600 people a week. I am grateful to all those of you who keep supporting the ministry generously and those of you who faithfully volunteer your time to help with the distribution of food on Monday and Friday evenings.

I continue to appeal to you to support the CK fund financially. For those of you who are unable to support financially and can give of your time with the distribution of food, your assistance is most welcome too.

Support for the Cathedral: Despite our having to contend with many challenges I am extremely grateful to many of you who support the work of the Cathedral generously. Your support is greatly appreciated and valued.

The last year has also been a different experience with Rachel being away overseas. 2024 will hopefully help me spend more time with them as I enter a new season in life.

The Lord, bless you and keep you, the Lord make His face to shine upon you and be gracious unto you; The Lord lift up the light of His countenance upon you and give you Peace.




